

Project: NWEI Discussion courses offered during the fall and winter/spring Adult Religious Education sessions (ARE)

Northwest Earth Institute discussion courses have been offered during the UUC ARE sessions. In the Fall 2007 ARE session the course **Choices in Sustainable Living** had 12 participants. The winter/spring 2008 ARE session had two NWEI courses offer: **Changing Course: Global Warming** with 10 participants and **Discovering a Sense of Place** with 6 participants. The fall 2008 ARE session had the **Menu for the Future** course with 11 participants. The Winter/spring 2009 ARE session has **Menu for the Future** offered again on a different evening of the week since there were requests for the class. The NWEI discussion courses have offered participants an opportunity to read more deeply on an environment topic, discuss it with others and make connections on how to take action and live more intentionally.
